

God had a plan for His Son, King Jesus.

A plan that He leaves the splendor and glories of heaven for a season.

God's plan included that He would experience pain and suffering. King Jesus was conceived by the Holy Spirit and was borne by a virgin. How impossible did that appear to the public during that time? *It was God's plan.* 

Our way of describing the stable where King Jesus was born, would be plain, common, and unsuitable, not fit for a King. *But it was God's plan*.

A commandment was issued that every boy child 2 years and under should be killed. God informed Joseph in a dream to take Mary and his Son Jesus, and travel to another area to get away from the commandment. It was God's plan to spare His Son from death at that time.

Joseph and Mary did not know all the details of *God's plan* when they were on this earth, they had a daily life just like you and I, making a living to implement food and clothing for their family.

Annually Jesus and His family traveled to Jerusalem for the Passover festival. On their journey home, they discovered Jesus was missing. After 3 days they found Him in the temple listening and asking the teachers questions. Mary, His mother, asked Him, "Son why have you treated us like this? Your Father and I have been anxiously searching for you." *They did not know God's plan for their Son Jesus*.

Why were you searching for me? Jesus asked. "Didn't you know I had to be in my Father's House?"

Joseph and Mary did not understand what Jesus meant. However, Mary treasured all these things in her heart, even though, *she did not know God's plan*.

If given a choice on how King Jesus should be born, I believe that none of us would have chosen for Him to be born in a stable. *But that was God's plan*.

How would you have chosen the plan of Salvation? *God had a plan*.

God's plan is so much higher, than our thoughts. Perhaps some of you would not have chosen the journey you are on or have been in the past, could it be that it is God's plan? So it will help you mature emotionally and spiritually? So you can become an encourager and inspiration to others?
